

Curved Log Cabin Block

Begins with center square;
can be either wide or
narrow width size.
Generally the wide strips
are twice the width of the
narrow strips.

For sample purposes we are using the large center square. Add strips in a clockwise direction, beginning with narrow strips. All blocks are two fabrics:

- Fabric 1: Leaf or Flower (could be scrappy)
- Fabric 2: Background

Cutting Measurements

Wide strips cut from a 1 1/2" strip of fabric
(approx 27" per set)

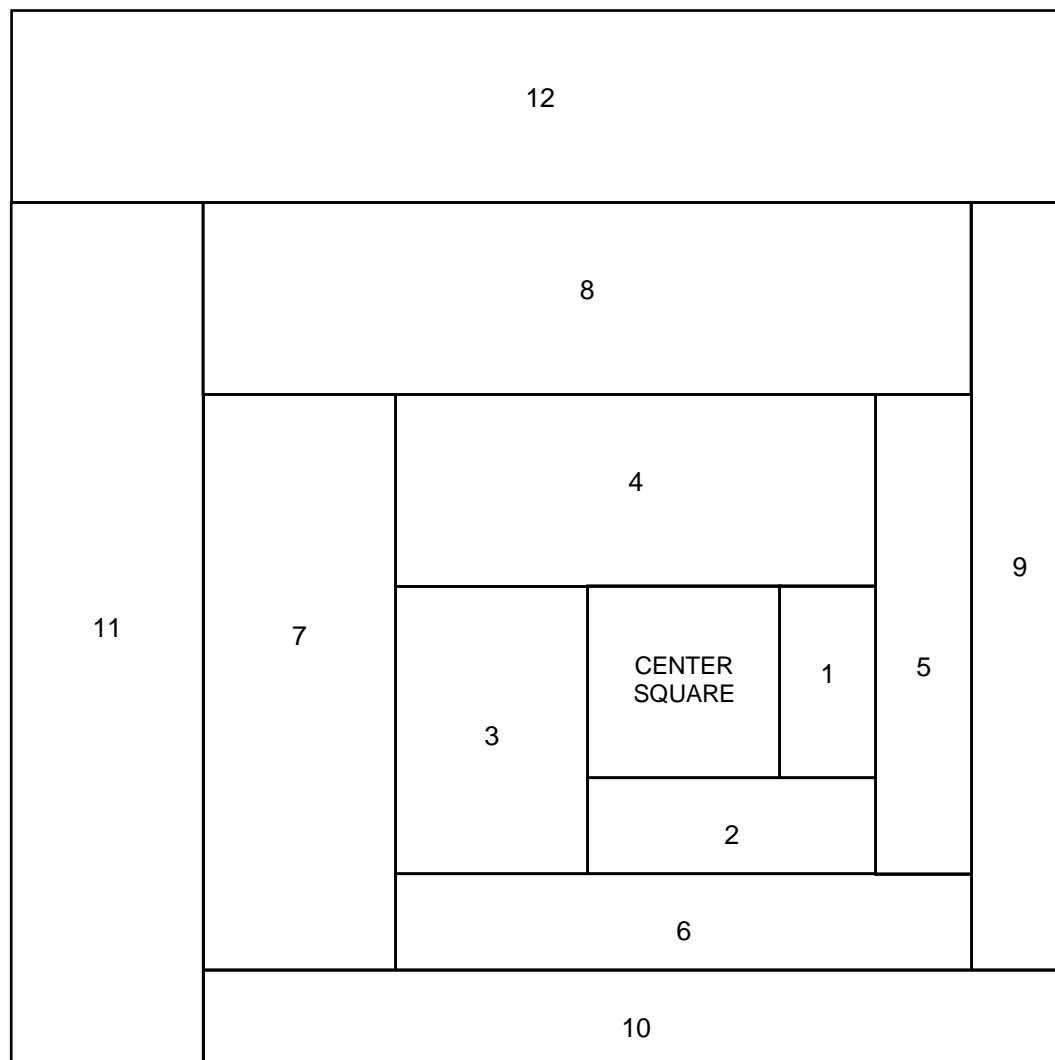
3 sets background
 3 sets flower
 2 sets leaf
 Center square 1 1/2" X 1 1/2"
 Piece 3 cut 1 1/2" X 2"
 Piece 4 cut 1 1/2" X 3"
 Piece 7 cut 1 1/2" X 3 1/2"
 Piece 8 cut 1 1/2" X 4 1/2"
 Piece 11 cut 1 1/2" X 5"
 Piece 12 cut 1 1/2" X 6"

Narrow strips cut from a 1" strip of fabric
(approx 20" per set)

5 sets background
 3 sets leaf
 Piece 1 cut 1" X 1 1/2"
 Piece 2 cut 1" X 2"
 Piece 5 cut 1" X 3"
 Piece 6 cut 1" X 3 1/2"
 Piece 9 cut 1" X 4 1/2"
 Piece 10 cut 1" X 5"

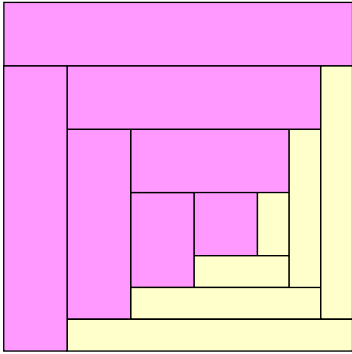
Cut 1 — 6" square of background fabric for 9th block

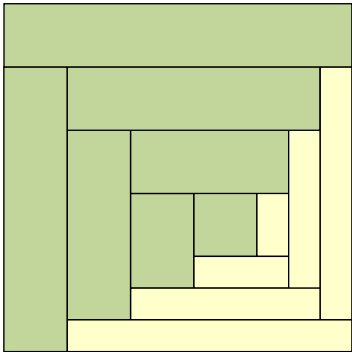


Rosebud Wall Hanging

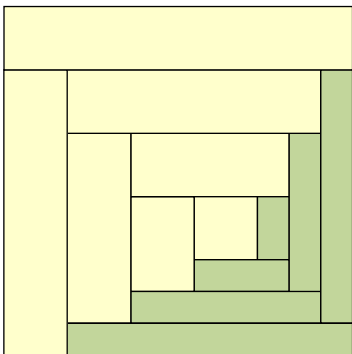
MAKE 3 FLOWER WIDE STRIP BLOCKS

MAKE 3 LEAF NARROW STRIP BLOCKS



- Requires 8 Curved Log Cabin Blocks and one plain* background block
- Finished blocks measure 5 ½" square

* The background block can be pieced to match the other blocks.
