

Teddy Bear Vest for CASA 2010

Teddy Bear Vest

Check the pattern. If it was printed correctly, the center back edge will be 5". If it did not print correctly, check to be sure that you have Page Scaling set to "None".

Select 2 complementary bright and pretty fabrics and 18" of coordinating ribbon.

Cut out 2 fronts and 1 back (on fold) of each fabric. Cut the ribbon into two 9" lengths.

Using 1/4" seam, join the fronts and the back at the shoulders. With right sides together, pin the two vests together. Insert the two pieces of ribbon between the two vests at the "X", with the ribbon inside.

Sew around the entire vest, leaving the side seams unstitched. Clip the armhole and neckline curves. Turn right side out by putting a safety pin in the side seam of a front, then pushing the safety pin through the shoulder and out one side seam of the back. On the second front, be sure to push it out the same side as the first one. Press. Stitch the side seams together on one fabric. Tuck the second fabric into the seam and whip stitch it together.

Well, after all, you know how to do this, as we did it before!!!

Have Fun! I'll bring a clothesline on August 24th, and we'll hang the vests. Let's fill that clothesline with vests for the CASA Teddy Bears!!!!
